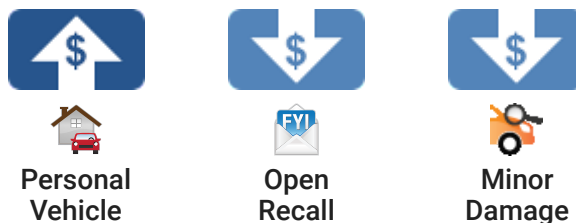

Description: Toyota is recalling model year 2000-2003 Tundra vehicles originally sold in or currently registered in the following states: CT, DE, IL, IN, KY, MA, MD, ME, MI, MN, NH, NJ, NY, OH, PA, RI, VA, VT, WI & WV and the District of Columbia. Excessive corrosion of the rear cross member may cause the separation of the spare tire stowed under the truck bed. Also, corrosion of the rear cross member could affect the rear brake lines at the proportioning valve. Excessive corrosion may also be exhibited on the fuel tank mounting system, which includes 2 other cross-members and the fuel tank straps.

Spare tire separation will create a road hazard for following vehicles and could cause a crash without prior warning. Corrosion of the rear cross member affecting the brake line at the proportioning valve will increase vehicle stopping distance and could cause a crash without prior warning. Remedy: Owners of vehicles covered by this campaign should bring their vehicle to a participating Toyota dealer located in one of the Cold Climate States for which authorization to apply the CRC has been obtained. The dealer will inspect the vehicle's frame (including the Rear Cross-Member and surrounding components such as the fuel tank mounting system, the brake lines at the proportioning valve, and spare tire carrier). * The dealer will then perform any of the applicable repairs and apply the CRC to the rear portion of the frame. In addition, if the Fuel Tank Straps have not previously been replaced, the dealer will replace them as part of this campaign. The work will be performed at no charge.






Description: Toyota is recalling model year 2000-2003 Tundra vehicles originally sold in or currently registered in the following states: CT, DE, IL, IN, KY, MA, MD, ME, MI, MN, NH, NJ, NY, OH, PA, RI, VA, VT, WI & WV and the District of Columbia. Excessive corrosion of the rear cross member may cause the separation of the spare tire stowed under the truck bed. Also, corrosion of the rear cross member could affect the rear brake lines at the proportioning valve. Excessive corrosion may also be exhibited on the fuel tank mounting system, which includes 2 other cross-members and the fuel tank straps. This is a supplement to campaign BXD and intended for customers whose vehicles are covered under Safety Recall BXD but are no longer registered in the covered states.

Spare tire separation will create a road hazard for following vehicles and could cause a crash without prior warning. Corrosion of the rear cross member affecting the brake line at the proportioning valve will increase vehicle stopping distance and could cause a crash without prior warning. Excessive corrosion to the fuel tank mounting system may cause the fuel tank to drop to the ground and be dragged or separated from the vehicle which may create a road hazard which could cause a crash without prior warning or possibly a fire.


Remedy: Customer's whose vehicles are covered by campaign BXD may request dealerships located outside of the Cold Climate States to complete this campaign. Due to state and/or local regulatory requirements, these dealerships are currently unable to perform the CRC application as required under campaign BXD. In an effort to support customers covered by campaign BXD, but no longer living in a Cold Climate State, Toyota is creating a supplemental campaign designation known as "BZD". An authorized Toyota dealer will inspect the vehicle's frame (including the Rear Cross-Member and surrounding components such as the fuel tank mounting system, the brake lines at the proportioning valve, and spare tire carrier). The dealer will then perform any of the applicable repairs. In addition, if the Fuel Tank Straps have not previously been replaced, the dealer will replace them as part of this campaign. The work will be performed at no charge to the vehicle owner. Please note, campaign BXD will remain open to ensure the customer may receive the CRC application if the vehicle ever returns to a Cold Climate State.

Glossary

Accident Indicator

Damage Severity

Damage events result in one of the following severity levels:

- Minor: Generally, minor damage is cosmetic (including dents or scratches), may only require reconditioning, and typically does not compromise a vehicle's operation and/or safety.
- Moderate: Moderate damage may affect multiple components of the vehicle and may impair the vehicle's operation and/or safety.

Ownership History
